

The Youth Orchestra Award of Jeunesses Musicales Germany

The slightly different orchestra competition



You are more than a musician....You are more than a conductor...You are more than an orchestra...

The German Youth Orchestra Award is more than a Competition!



Who can participate:

- symphonic youth orchestras
- symphonic wind orchestra
- a maximum of 20% of the participants of the orchestras are allowed to be 2

Criteria:

- Chose your own "motto", find your own special topic = the young musicians come up with their own ideas for a concert setup, the music, the theme, etc.
- active collaboration of the young musicians = participants of the orchestras organize the concert in all ways (planning, marketing, realisation, etc.)
- musical quality of the performance



Prizes:

- 1. Prize: 3000 €
- 2. Prize: 2000 €
- 3. Prize: 1000 €

How does it work:

• online registration on the JMD-website www.jugendorchesterpreis.de

• all registered orchestras receive the guidelines to prepare for the application and the competition

• the orchestras applies to participate and sends in all necessary documents and information as described in the guidelines

• a committee of JMD reviews all applications and nominates 15 candidates to participate in the competition

• the nominated orchestras start to prepare for their competition-concert. During the preparation they are entitled to a coaching in any matter/field they feel they need help. They contact JMD and get a specialized coach to work on the issue together with the orchestra members for a coaching that takes places wherever the orchestra has its home

• from October to June the competition concerts need to take place and a juror visits the concert on behalf of the committee

• with the help of questionnaires etc. the juror evaluates all criteria of the competition by listening to the concert, interviewing the participants and organizers of the youth orchestra, etc.

at the end of the competition period all jurors come together to evaluate all
15 concerts and to decide on the winners.

• apart from the three monetary prizes sometimes special awards are granted for extraordinary achievements (social impact, etc.)

• a youth orchestra camp is organized in Weikersheim where 2-4 musicians of all the participating orchestras come together for a weekend to discuss their experiences, rehearse together in a special ensemble and to perform at the award-ceremony

• the award ceremony is held in Weikersheim and every winning ensemble is presented with a short speech by the juror
